



English plus Internship (unpaid work)

Our programme combines high quality English tuition at GEOS with a placement in a business or organisation in a wide range of areas of commerce, industry and services. It offers both students and those with some work experience a great opportunity to internationalise their working experience.

This is a “sandwich” course where you study English before your placement and after it (for students who require a student visa for the UK). Students from the EU must take an English course before their placement, but can choose to return to the school afterwards.

Our placements are in businesses and organisations in the city of Brighton and Hove, or in towns near to it.

Payment: The work placement is unpaid, but some companies may help with the cost of transport to and from work.

Application: You will need to complete an application form, send us your CV/Resume in English and write a general letter of application. Some companies or organisations may ask to interview you over the telephone or after you arrive in the UK for your English course.

Accommodation: In the high season our partner agency may arrange this for you. In the school's low season (October-June) you will normally stay with your GEOS host-family.

Entry Requirements: You need at least an intermediate level of English. GEOS can send you a test so that we can advise you.

Certificate: You will receive a GEOS English Academy certificate at the end of your programme. You will also receive a reference and report from the company or organisation you worked for.

Programme Structure

For students who require a visa, the total English programme needs to be the same length of time as the work placement and must form a “sandwich” with at least 2 weeks of English study before and after the internship placement.

For students from the EU/EEA the minimum period of English study is 2 weeks before the internship placement.

Please remember when planning the programme that your level of English must be at a good intermediate level before beginning a placement.
